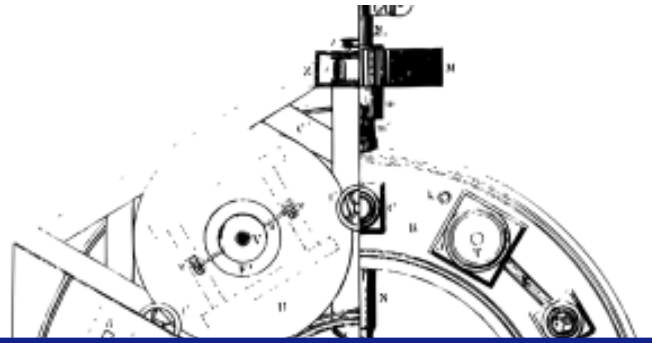

New Interfaces for TTS and PowerSuite

TMW is constantly finding ways to enhance your operations. One of those ways is to make sure that you have access to the best software out there to run your business. Right now, we are actively working on a **Terion** mobile communication interface for all 3 platforms PS, TL2K, and TTS with a release in early June for PS, mid June for TL2K, mid July for TTS. We are also beginning development work on a mobile communication interface to **Eaton** that should be ready in the next couple of months.

Free MapLinks Upgrade

We are offering MapLinks 32 bit application as a free upgrade for all customers who have previously purchased Maplinks. This version is an enhanced visual display of equipment specific locations with more traditional Windows functionality for ease of use. Contact your account manager for more details.

PowerSuite's Order Scheduler

It gets very repetitive creating the same trips over and over again. With PowerSuite's Order Scheduler, you eliminate the need to manually enter trips that are standard business such as: 1) trips to the same location, 2) on the same days of the week, or 3) at the same time of day. Instead you set up a template for a particular type of trip and establish a trip schedule that is based on that template. The system automatically creates new trips by making copies of the template saving you time and headaches!

Zip Codes Look Ups

With Release 2000, PowerSuite now supports zip-to-zip look-ups for users of the PC*Miler's ALK mileage interface. When you've configured the system to do mileage lookups by zip code, you can run the Populate Zip Codes feature in System Administration to have the system create a cross reference of cities and zip codes. There is no longer a need to overload your company master file with those one time pick-up or drop-off locations, now you can just enter the zip code and the program will do the mileage lookup for you.

How'd You Do That? (PowerSuite)

Q. How do I set up the fuel surcharge rate if I want to base it on miles?

A. If the fuel surcharge is a standard per mile rate (for example, you always want to apply an extra 2 cents per mile for the surcharge), do the following:

1. In the Rate Schedules application, select the Charge Types option under the Edit menu. Then click Add.
2. Set up a charge type called Fuel Surcharge that is based on distance (miles). The following fields must be set as shown here:

Basis: Accessorial

Unit: Miles

Unit Basis: Distance

Rate Unit: \$/mile

3. Set up a secondary rate for the fuel surcharge. In the Invoice Charge field in the rate header, select the charge type you established in Step 2. In the secondary rate, specify the per mile amount(s) to be applied when orders are billed.
4. Attach the secondary rate to the applicable primary rate(s).

Q. How do I set up the fuel surcharge rate if I want to base it on a percent of line haul revenue?

A. If the fuel surcharge is a standard percent of revenue (for example, you always want to apply 2% for the surcharge), do the following:

1. In the Rate Schedules application, select the Charge Types option under the Edit menu. Then click Add.
2. Set up a charge type called Fuel Surcharge that is based on revenue (dollars). The following fields must be set as shown here:

Basis: Accessorial

Unit: U.S. Dollars

Unit Basis: Revenue

Rate Unit: \$/Dollar

3. Set up a secondary rate for the fuel surcharge. In the Invoice Charge field in the rate header, select the charge type you established in Step 2. In the secondary rate, specify the percent of revenue amount(s) to be applied when orders are billed. (Be sure to enter the percent of revenue amounts in decimal form. For example, 2% would be entered as .02.)
4. Attach the secondary rate to the applicable primary rate(s).
