Built-in functions include Percent Profit per Month, Revenue per Mile, and Total Miles by Revenue Class.

With eLink, TMW client carriers save significant time and effort and reduce frustration on both sides by letting their shippers log on through the Internet to track their own orders (check on shipment statuses and ETAs) and place orders—all without carrier staff involvement (see separate press release).
